Diploma Program

Adults age 18 and older without a high school diploma can take classes and/or demonstrate competency to complete Washington State high school diploma requirements and earn a Big Bend Community College high school diploma or prepare for the GED exam series. Tuition is \$25 per quarter.

Entry Requirements: HS+ Students should bring HS transcripts and records of previous training, and employment or volunteer documentation for their orientation appointment, which will allow them to quickly start the program and have fewer credits needed for diploma.

ODP provides young adults, ages 16-21, with an opportunity to earn a high school diploma in a college environment. Tuition and books are provided at no cost to the student. Students earn a diploma from the school district of enrollment.

Entry Requirements: Students will contact a counselor at their district for referral. Students must be no younger than 16 years old and no older than 20 years old on September 1 of the school year that they are enrolling in. Students must be deficient in credits and have a referral from a school counselor identifying ODP as a suitable option for them.
