

The Board respects and encourages the right of its employees, as citizens, to engage in political activities including, but not limited to: voting, expressing their opinion on all political subjects and candidates, soliciting support (financial or otherwise) for or against any candidate or issue, running for and holding any political office or political party office, or participating in the management of a partisan political campaign. It is the intent of the Board of Trustees with this policy to establish guidelines restricting the use of District property and employment time for these endeavors and to avoid conflicts of interests in compliance with applicable laws.
