In accordance with state law and regulations, Big Bend Community College offers tuition and fee waivers for specific categories of students. The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) regulates the use of waivers, and determines which waivers colleges must offer to students, and which waivers are optional. (Relevant Resources: State Board for Community & Technical Colleges Tuition Waivers and Residency Classification)

Big Bend Community College implements the following Mandatory waivers per statute

- Children and Spouse of Totally Disabled or POW/MIA or Deceased Eligible
 Veterans or National Guard Members
- Children and Spouses of Deceased or Disabled Law Enforcement Officers or Firefighters
- Wrongfully Convicted Person

Big Bend Community College implements the following Mandatory waivers per SBCTC Policy

- Adult Basic Education, English as a Second Language, and GED® Preparation
- Apprenticeship

Big Bend Community College may implement optional waivers authorized by law and per SBCTC policy, as may be determined by the College President. Optional waivers currently available to BBCC students will be addressed in Administrative Process 6101.
