Helpful Hints


- Admission into the BAS-AM program is required for all upper division (300 and 400-level) courses.
- Meet with your advisor to determine which courses to incorporate into your education plan!

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Apply to BBCC
- Complete Associate degree or 90 college-level credits from accredited institution
- 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Apply to BAS-AM program opens February 1st!
- Complete pre-requisite coursework earning a 2.0 GPA or above in:
 - ENGL&101
 - College-level math
 - Humanities course
 - Social Science course
