### **Helpful Hints**


- ACCT 105, Intro to Accounting, is recommended before taking ACCT&201.
- Cumulative GPA must be 2.0 or higher
- Meet with your advisor each quarter to make sure you are on track!
- Instead of 3, 1-credit PEH activity courses you can take PEH 178 or 100 (3 credits)
