This program cannot be completed entirely online. Courses are offered on-campus, online, or hybrid (part on-campus, part online).

Program Requirements

- Students must pass both a Washington State
 Patrol and Washington Department of
 Children, Youth, and Families background
 check prior to program entrance.
- Students are also required to provide results of a Tuberculin skin test, proof of Covid-19 vaccination or an approved medical or religious examption, and obtain Washington Education Association liability insurance, prior to enrolling in ECED&120 (Practicum).


