The goal of Big Bend Community College is to encourage success in English. Realistic placement is critical for a student’s success. In addition to our assessment test, students who graduated high school within the past two years may be placed according to the following chart. In order to place by transcript:

1. Students must have earned a C or higher in their last English class.
2. Students must have a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher.
