

Big Bend STEPS TO VA ENROLLMENT

REQUIRED STEPS:

1. Apply for VA Education Benefits

- Visit www.va.gov to apply
- → This application will generate your Certificate of Eligibility in 30 days

2. Apply for Admissions at BBCC

- Visit https://www.bigbend.edu/i-am/new-student/
- Complete the application on-line
- Once you receive your <u>Welcome Email</u> from admissions in CTC Message Center, follow the steps to complete New Student orientation and enrollment

3. Submit Prior Transcripts

Send prior <u>official</u> transcripts, including Joint Service Transcripts to admissions. Contact <u>kerrif@bigbend.edu</u> if you have any questions.

4. Submit BBCC Veteran Reporting Form

Submit completed Reporting Form to Certifying Official at: <u>VeteranServices@bigbend.edu</u>. Form can be found on our website under the Veteran Services page.

5. Take Placement Tests

- Schedule an appointment for placement testing at 509-793-2064 (\$20 fee)
- Or, show completion of college level Math & English classes by submitting prior transcripts.

6. Enroll for Classes

Attend New Student Enrollment session to enroll for classes and to learn about BBCC resources.

- You must notify the School Certifying Official <u>each quarter</u> when your schedule is final and you're ready to be certified. Fill out the on-line form emailed to you each quarter.
- You must notify the School Certifying Official if you want to change your program.
- You must contact the School Certifying Official <u>if you want to change your schedule</u> <u>after you have been certified.</u>
- You must maintain <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u> to be eligible for VA Education Benefits.

FAQ'S

Q: How much is the monthly housing allowance?

A: For 100% eligible Post-9/11 GI B1H® recipients enrolled in at least 12 credits (w/ at least one residential class), the MHA is approx. \$1,698/month (The VA prorates MHA based on different variables)

Q: Will the VA pay for all of my classes?

A: The VA will only pay for the classes that are required for the completion of your degree.
