## Student Tuition Easy Payment Plan

BBCC is helping make college tuition easier to pay. The Student Tuition Easy Payment Plan (STEPP) allows students to pay tuition on a schedule that makes budgeting the costs a snap.

Once enrolled in classes, students may pay tuition and fees in three easy installments over the academic quarter rather than one large payment at the start of the quarter. Students must pay a \$15 charge per academic quarter to participate in STEPP. Once an account is established, students may budget their tuition payment the same as rent, car and insurance payments.

Using this installment plan, students may use cash, a personal check, or debit/credit card to pay.

## Placement Testing

Placement tests are given by appointment only. Call the Testing Center at 509.793.2064 or stop by in person (Bldg. 1000) to schedule. Photo ID, receipt of payment, and your BBCC ID number are required at the time of testing.

There is a \$10.00 fee for each test. Placement testing fees should be paid prior to testing at the BBCC Business Office in the 1400 building (open at 7:30 a.m.). Keep the receipt as you will need to present it when you take the test(s). If you have not pre-paid for the test, plan to arrive early so you can be at the testing center on time.

Math results are available at the completion of the test. English results are available Tuesday of the following week.

We release placement results only to the person taking the exam or with written authorization from that person. We cannot release exam scores over the telephone. ## New Student Advising/Registration & Orientation

New student advising/registration sessions begin June 15 and are scheduled throughout the summer. You must be officially admitted to BBCC to participate in an advising/registration session. Once you have applied for admission and paid the \$30.00 application fee you will receive an invitation to attend a session. You should make your reservation as soon as possible to assure a place. Attending an advising/registration session gives you an opportunity to meet with BBCC advisors, learn about programs offered, and register for classes.

In addition to applying for admission, you must take the math and English tests prior to your advising/registration session. Assessment results are needed for advising purposes. Placement testing dates and times are included in this schedule.

If you are a transfer student with 30 or more credits you do not need to attend an advising/registration session and may register beginning Friday, May 22 at 7:30 a.m. or anytime after. You are encouraged to see a BBCC advisor prior to registering for classes.

New student orientations will be held September 18 (evening) & 19 (day). Specific information about times and activities planned will be sent to all new students.
